

President Gerken convened the public meeting of Hanover Borough Council Wednesday Evening February 5, 2014 at 5:00 PM in the Hanover Municipal Building, 44 Frederick Street, Hanover, Pennsylvania, as advertised.

The meeting started with the Pledge of Allegiance followed by a moment of silent prayer.

On roll call the following Hanover Borough Council Members answered as present: Mr. Eline, Mr. Funke, Mr. Gerken, Mrs. Griffin, Mr. Marcoccio, Mr. McLin, Mr. Morris, Mr. Reichart, Mr. Roth and Mrs. Yingling; Mayor Adams; Solicitor Yingst; Manager Krebs and Secretary Miller. Absent was Junior Councilperson Sheaffer. Present for the regional joint bid opening were the following representatives of local governments: Marcy Krum, Conewago Township; Tom Osborne, Germany Township; Scott Cook, McSherrystown Borough; Jeff Garvick, Penn Township; Jack Freet, Union Township; and West Manheim Township had no representative present.

### **CITIZENS WITH ITEMS OF BUSINESS TO BE BROUGHT BEFORE COUNCIL**

None was presented.

### **REPORTS OF THE STANDING COMMITTEES**

#### **Public Service Committee – Mr. Eline**

It was moved by Mr. Eline, seconded by Mr. Funke to approve the request of Christy Hughes, Westminster, Maryland to hold the 2<sup>nd</sup> annual 5K Run/Walk "Race for Lori" on Saturday, March 29<sup>th</sup> beginning at 7:00 AM and utilizing the Moul Field Recreational area including use of bathrooms as per her Special Event Request Application, letter of request and race route map provided that:

- a. Race start time begins promptly at 8:00 AM.
- b. Sidewalks are not blocked for use by other pedestrians.
- c. Borough streets used are closed to all vehicular traffic during the race event; flagman are placed at barricades within the Borough to protect runners.
- d. Race events are completed and streets reopened no later than 10:30 AM.
- e. A certificate of insurance is provided naming The Borough of Hanover as a co-insured for the event.
- f. All food vendors to obtain all proper health licensing prior to the event.
- g. Bathrooms will be made available based on current weather conditions.
- h. Area is policed for litter following the event.

Motion carried.

It was moved by Mr. Eline, seconded by Mrs. Griffin to approve the request of Hanover Honda, 1226 Carlisle Street, Hanover to hold their 7<sup>th</sup> Annual Easter Egg Hunt on Saturday, April 19, 2014 from 11:00 AM to 5:00 PM at O'Brien Field with use of bathrooms as per their special event application received January 14, 2014, provided any children in the neighborhood are invited to participate in the event, the area and bathrooms are cleaned and policed for litter following the event, and waiving the \$500 Special Event Permit Fee for the event.

Mr. Eline noted that at an upcoming Public Service Committee meeting, there needs to be discussion on more flexibility of fees with the type of events being requested, to be determined by the degree of Borough costs involved in implementation of the particular event. There was further discussion and it was determined that the fee is being waived in this instance due to the minimal amount of Borough costs involved, and the lack of a fee being charged to patrons of the event.

On roll call, the following voted in favor of the motion: Mr. Eline, Mr. Gerken, Mrs. Griffin, Mr. McLin, Mr. Morris, Mr. Reichart, Mr. Roth and Mrs. Yingling. The following members voted in opposition to the motion: Mr. Funke and Mr. Marcoccio. The motion passed 8 in favor; and 2 in opposition. Motion carried.

## REPORTS OF THE STANDING COMMITTEES

### Water & Sewer Committee – Mr. Reichart

It was moved by Mr. Reichart, seconded by Mr. Funke to authorize staff to finalize the necessary steps to file a water rate increase in July 2014 with the assistance of Gannett Fleming Engineering and Rhoads & Sinon Attorneys. Motion carried.

Mr. McLin questioned how much of an increase was being sought; Manager Krebs replied that the process is now in place to formulate how much of an increase is needed.

### JOINT BID OPENING

Bid tabulations will be forwarded to all bidders after the February 26, 2014 meeting. Opening and recording tonight is without reference to the validity-acceptability of the bid document, which will be determined by the public bodies in public session.
