**MANDATORY GARBAGE COLLECTION AND CURBSIDE HOME RECYCLING—GREEN STICKER**

You will receive a service sticker for three (3) 30-gallon residential garbage can collection service for 2015 in February. This sticker entitles you to full service pickup of household refuse/garbage when put in 30-gallon garbage cans or bags placed outside your home, with the exception of mandatory **CURBSIDE** recycling of bi-metal/aluminum, corrugated cardboard/paperboard, and newspapers. Fees for this service in 2015 are **\$73.50/qtr. or \$294.00/yr.**; if paid by February 20th for the year, a 5% discount will be applied making the fee **\$279.30**. When you receive your service sticker please display on your house or post near your pickup site so the collector can easily see it. ***NO REFUNDS WILL BE GIVEN ON YEARLY PAYMENTS.***



EXTRA TAGS CAN BE PURCHASED AT THE BOROUGH OFFICE FOR **\$4.00** EACH FOR EXTRA CANS OVER YOUR (3) THREE CANS LIMIT.



Glass bottles (clear & colored) and quality paper can be dropped off at the Recycling Center on North Street

**MONTHLY MANDATORY HOME CURBSIDE COLLECTION OF THE FOLLOWING RECYCLABLES: ALUMINUM/BI-METAL CANS (can be commingled in same bin), NEWSPAPER (needs to be bundled and kept dry) & CORRUGATED CARDBOARD/PAPERBOARD, (which must be broken down and bundled). THESE ITEMS MUST BE PLACED AT THE SAME LOCATION YOU PLACE YOUR REGULAR REFUSE ON YOUR DESIGNATED DAY FOR YOUR MONTHLY RECYCLING PICKUP. REMINDER: THERE IS A DIFFERENT TRUCK TO PICK UP EACH ITEM SEPARATELY**

**ELECTRONIC RECYCLING IS MANDATORY. ALL ELECTRONICS CAN BE RECYCLED AT PENN TOWNSHIP'S RECYCLING FACILITIES AT 1020 WILSON AVENUE IN HANOVER, PA MON—FRI 8-4:15 pm/ SATURDAYS 8-3 pm**

**RECYCLE & HELP US HOLD DOWN INCREASING COST:** Remember a household generates 1 ton of refuse a year. Costs to the Borough for disposal of refuse are increasing. Every item that can be kept out of the garbage is a potential savings to all our users.

## ANSWERS TO COMMONLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1. **SPECIAL PICKUPS** - Must be requested for tree trimming materials, but a pickup fee related to time and volume of the pickup will be assessed. Phone the Public Works Dept. at 632-3939, to make pickup arrangements.
2. **LEAF PICKUP** - Leaves are collected as part of the Refuse service, in the fall season during the months of Nov. and Dec. (**“DO NOT BAG YOUR LEAVES”**). The leaves should be raked to your front gutter area to be picked up by the leaf collection machine. **“DO NOT PLACE BRUSH, WEEDS, OR GRASS IN THE GUTTER FOR PICKUP.”**
3. **ITEMS RECYCLED** - Bi-metal/aluminum cans, Newspaper, and Corrugated Cardboard/Paperboard are recycled curbside monthly. Please see schedule for pickup day. PLEASE REMEMBER ON RECYCLING DAY THERE WILL BE A DIFFERENT TRUCK COLLECTING EACH ITEM SEPARATELY.
4. **GRASS CLIPPINGS** - Bags of grass or grass containers are included in the 3 can limit & must have stickers attached if they exceed the 3 container limit.
5. **FOLLOWING HEAVY STORMS** - Fallen brush will be collected free of charge if stacked, not bundled, and Public Works is notified within 5 days of the storm damage occurring. (Collection for brush other than storm damage can be requested by contacting the Public Works Dept. at 632-3939. Charges based on volume & time required for service.)
6. **GARDEN WASTE** - Pickup will be COLLECTED WITH YOUR RECYCLABLES DURING THE MONTH OF MAY & OCTOBER. Collectibles must be placed in a closeable bag (paper or plastic are acceptable) and the Garden/Leaf Waste Sticker must be placed on the container and clearly visible by the hauler. Bags containing rock, grass, tree limbs or ground will not be accepted. Additional stickers can be picked up at the Borough Office at no charge. Residents may utilize the Drop Off center on North Street for branches, tree and shrub trimming and pulpy vines cut into (3) foot lengths and bundled to a weight of less than fifty (50) pounds.
7. **CHRISTMAS TREES** - ARE PICKED UP WITHOUT ADDED CHARGE IN JANUARY. Please remove plastic, wire & metal from trees as same can damage the tree chipping equipment & personnel.
8. **SPECIAL OR EXTRA PICKUPS** - At all other times large or bulky items can be picked up on request for a charge based on volume & time required for service. Phone the Public Works Dept. at 632-3939, to make pickup arrangements. **PLEASE REMEMBER TO REMOVE REFRIGERATOR & STOVE DOORS ON APPLIANCES PLACED OUT FOR SPECIAL PICKUP TO AVOID TRAPPING CHILDREN.** Tires, 5-gallon buckets, garbage cans, mattresses, box springs, & limbs/brush not bundled must all be considered SPECIAL PICKUP items & charges for disposal will be passed along to the person requesting pickup.
9. **HOLIDAY PICKUP SCHEDULE** - When regular pickup days fall on a holiday, that pickup will be made on the **Wednesday of that week.** All other collection remains on regular schedule.
10. **CONSTRUCTION WASTE** - cannot be disposed of by the Borough. Make sure your contractor has a means of disposing same.
11. **ELDERLY & HANDICAPPED** - residents who wish to have recyclables hauled to North Street can contact **BOB LARSEN at 632-5155** to arrange pickup by Boy Scout Volunteers.
12. **QUALITY PAPER** - Computer paper, white copier paper, white typing paper & similar office paper.
